Anderson Public Library Public Comment Policy

A time for comments from the public will be designated on the Library Board of Trustees meeting agenda during all public meetings. Comments from the floor should be relevant to Library matters, excluding personnel issues. Individual speakers are asked to limit their comment time to three minutes. The meeting chair may limit the time for individual speakers and may limit the total time allotted for public comments.

During this time, the public may express their ideas, opinions, and/or concerns about matters over which the Library Board of Trustees has authority and responsibility. Comments should be made in the form of statements and speakers may not engage the Library Board in a question and answer exchange during the meeting. Questions relating to Library or administrative procedures should be sent to the appropriate Library staff and addressed outside of the Library Board meeting.
